DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

Note:

(1) Per the terms of the BC System Integration Settlement dated November 3, 2006, the maximum aggregate incentive amount of \$48.5 million was realized in June 2011.

[&]quot;Agreed Amount" means, for any year during the Term, an initial amount equal to \$12,600,000, escalated by 3% per year commencing January 1, 2003, plus the addition of \$8,428,029 in 2011 for BC System Integration Settlement dated November 3, 2006.

[&]quot;Actual Amount" has the meaning as defined in Section 3.1 of the Settlement; the actual amount of General and Administrative Expenses for any year.

[&]quot;Incentive Saving" has the meaning as defined in Subsection 3.1(b)(ii) of the Settlement; the Agreed Amount less the Actual Amount for such year.

[&]quot;Collectible Amount" has the meaning as defined in Section 2.1 of the Settlement; two-thirds (2/3) of the outstanding principal balance of the Phase II Preliminary Expenditures at November 1, 2002.
